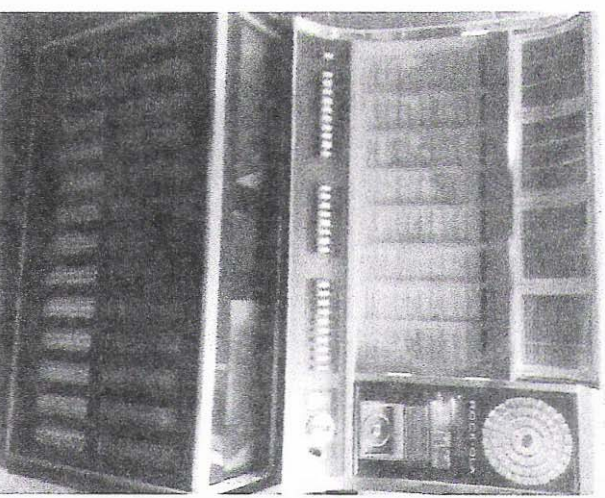

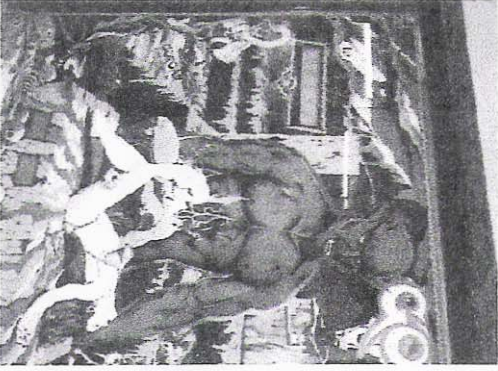

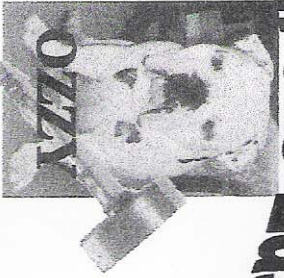

Brother Brad Paisley was born in Glen Dale, West Virginia in 1972 to a teacher and worker at the West Virginia DOT. Brad's grandmother bought him his first guitar and taught him how to play. He made his National debut in 1999 with his single *Who Needs Pictures* and performed at the Grand OI' Opry the same year. He continues to grace us with his chart topping-number ones, including: *I'm Gonna Miss Her*, *We Danced*, *Mud on the Tires*, and *When I Get Where I'm Going*.

Brad Paisley co-hosted the 44th Annual CMA Awards on November 10, 2010, where he was also awarded the CMA's top award, Entertainer of the Year. During his acceptance speech, Paisley emotionally honored his grandfather, who inspired him to play the guitar.

In 2012, MSN.com listed *American Saturday Night* as one of the 21 Essential 21st-Century Albums.¹ Paisley is a member of the Southern Jurisdiction of the of the Scottish Rite and a Noble of the AAONNMS, or Shriners. He was accompanied by his father, Doug Paisley for the ceremony on October 28, 2006.¹⁴⁵¹
